Commercial Exhibitors:

It's time once again to begin preparations for the Brown County Free Fair!

The commercial exhibits and non-commercial exhibits will be located in the climate controlled New Ulm Civic Center on the County Fairgrounds in New Ulm. If you want to have a booth in the Civic Center you can rent a booth for the low price of \$105.00. We also have outside booth space available for anyone who wants more space. Non-commercial (Open Class) exhibits will be located on the south side of the arena floor and commercial booths will be on the north side (next to the bleachers).

We also require proof of insurance which states:

- ✓ Name of the insured/company
- ✓ Type of coverage
- ✓ Limits of the policy
- ✓ Statement listing the Brown County Agricultural Society (Brown County Free Fair) as co-insured

The 2008 Brown County Free Fair runs from Wednesday, August 6 through Sunday, August 10. The Civic Center will be open each day as follows:

- ✓ **Wednesday** 5:00 – 10:00 p.m.
- ✓ **Thursday** 10:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. (Senior Citizens program is at 10:30 and we get a couple hundred seniors wanting to tour the commercial exhibits while they're at the fair. Having your booth available prior to noon is optional.)
- ✓ **Friday** 11:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. (Kids/Daycare Day participants come to the fair and register in the Civic Center and take part in a show on the stage in the Civic Center during the late forenoon. Having your booth available prior to noon is optional.)
- ✓ **Saturday** Noon - 10:00 p.m.
- ✓ **Sunday** Noon - 5:00 p.m. (Brown County Free Fair concludes at 5:00 p.m. on Sunday)

All exhibits must be removed from the Civic Center no later than 8:00 p.m. Sunday.

Since the New Ulm Civic Center is available to us at a discounted rate during the fair, we want to do everything we can to make the building comfortable for fair attendees but also want to be conscious of the cost of operating the building. Therefore, we will have the overhead door open only for set-up on Wednesday and take-down on Sunday. If you feel that your booth needs more exposure during the fair, feel free to request an outdoor booth space. We continue to improve the signage on the Civic Center to let our fair attendees know that the Commercial Exhibits are located inside, but we cannot guarantee that everyone will read the signs that are posted. We thank you for understanding and working with us on this.
